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DEFINITION

This is work primarily assisting Speech Language Pathologists implement and establish therapy plans to groups and/or individuals. Under the direction of the Director of Education Support Services or the Director of Early Childhood Services, duties include but are not limited to: assisting Speech Language Pathologists with client assessments/screenings; implementing therapy plans or programs with individual clients or in group sessions; assisting clients in activities; monitoring, recognizing and reporting/documenting on changes in client's status; preparing and organizing materials, equipment and documents for educational and therapy sessions; educating clients, parents and the community; and maintaining equipment and supplies.

N.B. Other related responsibilities may be assigned from time to time as may become necessary to the operation of the service.

QUALIFICATIONS

High school graduation plus an additional rehabilitation program/course of over one year or an equivalent combination of training and experience.
